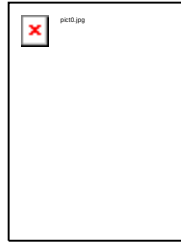

Once again we want to most sincerely thank and appreciate the Old Eastleigh Boys for their good gesture of making sure that the school is computerized. It is a very big boost to have the 30 computers and 1 Laptop.

We most sincerely also appreciate the visit of Mr. Jayant Tanna the Chairman of the Old Eastleigh Boys previously Eastleigh Re-Union.

We have observed some good positive changes in our teachers and students. We are still moving on in strengthening the computer rooms by burglar proofing the windows and the doors. We are preparing the tables and wiring the room and Mr. Jayant Tanna is aware that currently we are using our new Physics Laboratory as a computer room as we await the completion of the renovation of the two rooms that we shall permanently use as computer rooms. Each of these rooms will be able to hold about 56 computers. Therefore at the end of it all we shall have 56 x 2 that is a total of 112 computers in the two rooms. There is a small, room between the two rooms which will be used by the computer teachers and we shall install 4 computers, a server, Internet and a printer. All computers will be net worked.

Since our school will ultimately have a population of 940 students as per the schools registration certificate, we hope that with a hundred and twelve computers every student will have access to Information Technology. Plans are underway to make computer studies be an examinable subject at the National Examination — KCSE. Currently the boys are making full use of the computers in the Physics Laboratory. They are enjoying the exposure to computers which some of them have never touched before.

The computers are working very well. Our boys are excited and are enjoying learning the computer basics with the hands on activities.

Teachers are ready to face the challenges and are applying what they learnt from Mr. Jayant Tanna and they are looking forward to getting more information on how to improve.
